

AstraZeneca COVID-19 Vaccination

Kyoto Prefecture will begin accepting applications for the AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccination. At this time, eligible persons will include those who are aged 40 and older.

Eligible persons

Anyone who has a resident certificate in Kyoto Prefecture and meets any of the following criteria:

- Those who are allergic to ingredients such as polyethylene glycol, and as a result are unable to receive the mRNA vaccines (Pfizer, Takeda/Moderna)
- Those who have already received one dose of AstraZeneca outside of Japan.
- At this time eligible persons additionally include those who are aged 40 or older.

Information on AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccinations

Please be sure to read the following before you make a reservation for a vaccination:

- **The second dose will be given in early November.**
The dosing interval between the first and second dose is longer when compared with Pfizer (3 week interval) and Takeda/Moderna (4 week interval).
(The second dose of the AstraZeneca vaccine takes place 4 to 12 weeks after the first dose. However, it is necessary to wait for a period of at least 8 weeks before the second dose in order to obtain adequate vaccine efficacy.)
- **Rare cases of serious side effect of “blood clot with low blood platelets” have been reported.**
In the U.K., cases of those side effects have been reported in 14.9 per one million doses of the first shot, and 1.9 cases per one million doses for the second shot.
- **The efficacy rate of preventing symptomatic COVID-19 is reported to be around 70%.**
The efficacy of Pfizer is approximately 95%, with Takeda/Moderna being approximately 94%
