

Information on the large-scale Moderna vaccination program managed by Kyoto Prefecture

Please be advised that all reservations for the program have been closed as of Tuesday, September the 7th.

Persons who are eligible for a vaccine reservation at this venue

Individuals with registered residency in Kyoto Prefecture who are aged 40 or older* must meet the following conditions:

- Individuals for whom this will be their first vaccine shot
- Individuals who have NOT made a vaccine reservation via the national or municipal governments, medical institutions, or via workplaces

*Individuals who were born on or before April 1st, 1982

Free taxi shuttle service between Hosono Station and Keihanna Plaza

(No reservation required)

We will operate a free taxi shuttle service that will run every 5 minutes between Hosono Station and Keihanna Plaza.

*Only those who have made a vaccination reservation at a large-scale vaccination venue conducted by Kyoto Prefecture and their attendants are eligible to use this service.

*Reservations are not required for the free taxi shuttle service.

How to make a vaccine reservation

1. Do not make a double booking!
 - If you have already made a reservation at your municipal government and/or the Self-Defense Forces Osaka Large-scale Vaccination Center and at the Kyoto Prefectural Large-Scale Vaccination Venue, please cancel either one of the reservations immediately to avoid a double booking. If you make a double booking, the vaccine prepared for you will be wasted. Thank you for your cooperation.
 - Please note that information such as the vaccination coupon number for those who have made a reservation at the large-scale vaccination site in Kyoto Prefecture will be provided to the municipalities in the prefecture in order to prevent double reservations.
 - In addition, those who have been vaccinated at the large-scale vaccination site in Kyoto Prefecture cannot receive a vaccination managed by the municipal government, the national government, or workplaces.

2. After the first shot, a second shot is required after an interval of 4 weeks.
 - At the large-scale vaccination site, after receiving your first vaccination you will be able to reserve your second vaccination at the same venue on the spot.
 - In principle, the second vaccination will be reserved at the same time on the same day of the week for four weeks later.

3. When the reservation is completed, please make a note of the reservation date, time, and the place of the vaccination.

How to cancel a reservation

If you wish to cancel your reservation, please follow the instruction below.

Cancelling the booking in advance won't waste the vaccine dose as they can be provided to others who wish to receive it.

Cancellation for up to 2 days before your booking

Please cancel the booking through the website where you made your reservation.

(The navigation language is only Japanese)

1. Go to the Home page and tick "agree" to the terms and conditions and choose your vaccine venue where you made your booking.
2. Choose your municipality
3. Enter your booking number and your date of birth
4. Once you see your booking details on the screen, click "cancel the booking" at the bottom of the page
5. There will be a message pop up, asking "are you sure you wish to cancel the booking?" , click "OK" to cancel it completely
6. Once the booking is cancelled in the system, the message "There is no booking" will be displayed on the screen

What to bring on the day of your vaccination

Please bring all of the followings with you on both your first and second shot reservations. Without it, you may not be able to receive the shot.

- Vaccination coupon
 - Preliminary examination slip (please complete this in advance and bring it with you)
 - Identity verification documents (driver's license, health insurance card, etc.)
- *If you have a medicine notebook, please bring it with you.

Precautions for the day of the vaccination

- If a "storm warning" or "special warning" is announced in Kyoto City, vaccinations at the venue in front of JR Kyoto Station will be cancelled. If a "storm warning" or "special warning" is announced in Kameoka City, vaccinations at Sanga Stadium will be cancelled. If a "storm warning" or "special warning" is announced in Seika Town, vaccinations at Keihanna Plaza will be canceled.
- Regarding the implementation of vaccinations at the venue in front of JR Kyoto Station, if such an announcement is made before 1:00 p.m., it will be canceled.
- Regarding the implementation of the morning session at Sanga Stadium and/or Keihanna Plaza, if such an announcement is made before 7:00 a.m., it will be canceled.
- Regarding the implementation of the afternoon session at Sanga Stadium and/or Keihanna Plaza, if such an announcement is made before 10:00 a.m., it will be canceled.

In addition, if it is deemed necessary to set up the venue as an evacuation center due to an emergency, the administering of vaccinations will be canceled. Regarding the vaccinations at Sanga Stadium, if JR Sagano Line operations are suspended, vaccinations will be canceled.

- Please arrive at the venue during your allotted time in order to prevent crowding and possible infections. You cannot enter the venue before your allotted time. Furthermore, if you arrive too early, you may not be able to be seated in the waiting area.
- Following your first vaccination at large-scale vaccination venues, a booking for your second vaccination at the same venue will be accepted on the spot. As a general rule, the second vaccination will be reserved for the same time on the same day of the week for four weeks later.
- Check whether you have a fever or not before heading to the inoculation site.
- Please wear short sleeves on the day (The vaccination is usually injected into the deltoid muscle of the upper arm)
- After receiving the vaccine, you will undergo a period of health monitoring at the inoculation site for 15 or 30 minutes.
